QUADRIMEX SULFUR CHEMICALS (QSC)

A new subsidiary company for the QuadrimeX Group

On 1 May 2010, the QuadrimeX Group acquired 100% of the sulphur derivatives division of ChemComm Leuna GmbH (CCL), a German company and has renamed it QuadrimeX Sulfur Chemicals GmbH & Co, KG.*

QuadrimeX Group and CCL had been close business partners for several years. Following the death of CLL's Chairman and Owner in November 2009, the company went into receivership. QuadrimeX spent several months negotiating for the acquisition of its **Sulphur Products Division**.

*QSC manufactures and markets 3 large families of products:

Ammonium sulphide: in reaction with hydrogen sulphide with ammonia.

Sodium hydrosulphide: in reaction with hydrogen sulphide with sodium.

It comes three different forms:

- **Liquid (several concentrations)**
- **Paste**
- **Beads**

Sodium sulphide: hydrosulphide reacting with sodium.

QSC products are mainly used in:

- **Precipitation of heavy metals:** treatment of contaminated land and of organic waste in incinerators
- **Tannery**
- **Paper pulp**
- **Cosmetics** (hair removal cream, hair products, etc.)
- **Floatation of some minerals**
- **Sulphur-based dyes**

QSC's future plans include investing in its production capacity for existing products, expanding its product catalogue, and developing new sulphur products. QSC is the only manufacturer in Europe and world leader for ammonium sulphide products, with an annual production capacity of 14,000 tons.
